It's that time of year to begin thinking about the Farm Bureau Scholarship program. A total of eight scholarships will be awarded in 2019. There will be 4 scholarships awarded in the Non-Ag related field of study, these scholarships are \$1,000 each and 4 scholarships awarded in the Ag related field of study, these scholarships are \$1,500 each.

PLEASE MAKE NOTE: THE APPLICATION HAS BEEN UPDATED, IT WILL ONLY BE AVAILABLE ON OUR WEB SITE. PLEASE MAKE SURE ALL THE SCHOLARSHIPS ARE ON THE 2019 APPLICATION, ANY APPLICATIONS RECEIVED ANY OTHER WAY WILL NOT BE JUDGED. IF YOU HAVE GIVEN THE SCHOOLS IN YOUR AREA APPLICATIONS PLEASE MAKE SURE THEY HAVE THE RIGHT APPLICATION/INFORMATION. CERTIFICATION AND VERIFICATION OF MEMBERSHIP OF EACH APPLICANT IS REQUIRED BY THE COUNTY PRESIDENT.

The rules are:

*** Applications must be typed; written applications will not be judged.**

* Farm Bureau scholarships are limited to one per recipient.

* The Scholarship is available to a member of an Idaho Farm Bureau family for one year of higher education at an institution of their choice.

Required documents:

* An official notarized transcript of High School or if already attending college, an official notarized college transcript.

* Three current letters of recommendation must accompany all applications.

* Please include a photograph (no larger than 5x7) to be used for publicity purposes only. **Please don't use staples** to attach the picture to application.

Extra pages may be added if necessary. Incomplete applications will not be judged. All applications need to be on the current 2019 scholarship application. Do not put applications in folders.

Your county is limited to submitting **two complete** applications, one application in an Ag-Related field of study and one application in a non Ag-Related field of study.

The County Farm Bureau is responsible for the recommendation and selection of the county applications and researching the application as to membership and the qualifications of the applicant. The County President must interview each applicant before signing the completed application.

MONDAY, APRIL 1st IS THE DEADLINE FOR RECEIVING APPLICATIONS IN THE HOME OFFICE FROM THE COUNTIES IT'S UP TO THE COUNTY TO SET THEIR OWN DEADLINE. PLEASE MAKE SURE THE APPLICANT AND THE SCHOOLS KNOW WHEN THE COUNTY DEADLINE IS.
