1. SAE Name / Type / Pathway and SAE Subcategory (5%)	SAE name <u>clearly</u> communicates the project and base of production (5 pts.)	SAE name somewhat describes the project, but lacks communication of the base of production (acres, head, dollars, etc.). (4-3 pts.)	SAE name and information does not describe the project and need to be changed. (2-0 pts.)	
2. SAE Annual Scope (5%)	Annual scope is appropriately listed for each year of records and illustrates annual responsibility and describes the project. (5 pts.)	Annual Scope is listed, but lacks annual some details and needs slight revisions. (4-3 pts.)	Annual scope is incomplete or missing (2-0 pts.)	
3. SAE Plan - Description (10%)	Describes interest in this area, estimates dates of involvement, related courses and generally describes the project. (10-7pts.)	Includes general ideas, but lacks planned dates and how it relates to previous experiences. (7-4pts.)	Missing or lacks information and needs major revisions. (4-0 pts.)	
4. SAE Plan - Time (5%)	Describes commitment of time including planning and working in the project. Also, how time is planned to be balanced to other commitments. (5pts.)	Includes general ideas of time, but lacks clarity and needs minor revisions. (4-pts.)	Missing or lacks information and needs major revisions. (2-0 pts.)	
5. SAE Plan - Financial Investment (5%)	Describes estimated cost to purchase the project and related expenses, sources of funds, estimated income and any "non-cash" relate to the project. (5 pts.)	Includes general ideas, but Lacks details about financial needs or sources of funding for the project and needs minor revisions. (4-3pts.)	Missing or lacks information and needs major revisions. (2-0 pts.)	
6. SAE Plan - Capital (Non-current) (5%)	Describes capital items (Non-current) planned to be used in the project. Also includes how the items are provided such as beginning, purchased or labor exchanged. (5 pts.)	Includes general ideas, but lacks details or how items are obtained and needs minor revisions. (4-3 pts.)	Missing or lacks information and needs major revisions. (2-0 pts.)	
7. SAE Plan - Learning Outcomes (5%)	Describes what the student plans to learn from the project. (5 pts.)	Includes general ideas, but lacks measurable details. (4-3 pts.)	Missing or lacks information and needs major revisions. (2-0 pts.)	
8. SAE Budget (10%)	Describes an appropriate financial estimate for the project. (10-8 pts.)	Has information, but lacks details and needs revisions. (8-4 pts.)	Missing or lacks information and needs major revisions. (4-0 pts.)	
10. SAE Journals (25%)	SAE Journals represent the complete timeframe of the project, illustrate consistent engagement and are well written. (25-15 pts.)	SAE Journals represent the complete timeframe of the project, but are not consistent and need editing. (15-8 pts.)	Missing or lacks information and needs major revisions. (8-0 pts.)	
11. SAE Finances & Annual Income Statement (25%)	SAE finance details represent the complete timeframe of the project, illustrate appropriate finances for the scope/size of the project and the annual income statement is appropriate for the project. (25-15 pts.)	SAE finance details lack consistency for the time frame of the project or financial results (detail or annual income statement) are not complete. (15-8 pts.)	Financials are missing information and need major editing. (7-0 pts.)
